Precautionary Measures in Response to COVID-19

The studio will continue its measured approach with health and safety measures such as capacity control, health screenings, temperature checks, requiring face masks, social distancing, and increased cleaning and sanitization.

The regular rapid test arrangement for staff will be in effect.

For the safety of our students and staff, the studios, toilets and waiting area have been applied with Antibacterial Photocatalyst Coating.

Waiting Area

For students enrolled in our Children Programmes - Ballet 1 and up, only students may enter the studio. Our waiting areas will not be open for parents or guardians.

For students in Children Programmes - Pre-ballet 1 – 2. As these are our youngest students, a parent may enter the building with them, help them change their shoes and walk them into the studio. We appreciate your cooperation in leaving the building after dropping off your child.

'Vaccine Pass' Requirements

All visitors who enter or remain on the specified premises are required to fulfill the 'Vaccine Pass' requirements, unless exempted under the law. Students and visitors should carry at all times their COVID-19 vaccination record or Medical Exemption QR Code and present it to our staff for scanning upon entry of Studio A / Studio B as required.

Students under the age of 12 are exempted from the above requirement, yet are required to mark their attendance before entry into studios. (As of the latest update according to Government on 21 April 2021)

For students and visitors exempted from the 'Vaccine Pass' requirements, please indicate their exemption and produce the relevant proof as required to our staff. Otherwise, our staff may refuse their entry to the specified premises.
